

Visitor Code of Conduct

At the Fraser River Discovery Centre, the health and safety of our visitors, volunteers, and staff is our top priority. In accordance with the latest health orders and restrictions from the BC Health Authority, we have developed a set of routines to help ensure we do our part to stop the spread of COVID-19.

A visit to the FRDC should be a fun and memorable experience! To ensure this, please respect the following guidelines:

COVID-19 Safety

- Complete the [BC COVID-19 Self-Check](#) before your visit or at the door.
- Masks are mandatory for all staff and visitors aged 6 or older. In compliance with public health recommendations, face shields are only permitted while wearing a mask underneath.
- Please stay home if you feel unwell or are experiencing any [COVID-19 symptoms](#).
- Please use hand sanitizer provided upon entry, exit, and throughout the building.
- Maintain a 2-metre physical distance between you, other visitors, and staff.
- Follow directional signage and directions from staff throughout the Centre.

While at the Centre

- All children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an individual 16 years or older.
- Food and drinks may only be consumed outside the Centre.
- Strollers are permitted in all galleries, unless otherwise noted.

Events, rentals, and public programs

When attending an event, rental, or public programs inside the Centre, participants over 12 years old must be prepared to show:

- Valid government photo ID.
- A BC Vaccine Card, OR
- Other forms of proof of partial or full vaccination, such as an immunization record card from a clinic, pharmacy, or local health authority (until September 26). After September 26, only a BC Vaccine Card will be accepted.
- A provincially/territorially recognized vaccine record for guests visiting from outside BC.
- Proof of vaccination used to enter Canada for guests visiting from outside Canada.

Please note: After October 24, all participants will be required to be fully vaccinated.
