RiverFest will take place Saturday, September 27, and Sunday, September 28 from 10:00am to 4:00pm. As part of the RiverFest celebration, walking tours and workshops will take place on September 20 from 9:00am to 4:00pm.

We need volunteers for all three days during RiverFest. Volunteer shifts are available for both morning and afternoon on Saturday, September 20, September 27, and Sunday, September 28.

RiverFest activities and volunteer shifts will mainly take place at the Fraser River Discovery Centre and surrounding area; 788 Quayside Drive, New Westminster, BC, V3M 6Z6, apart from one workshop taking place at Tipperary Park; 315 Queens Avenue, New Westminster, BC, V3L 1K1.

Volunteer Roles:

Family Yoga at Tipperary Park – Assist participants during a playful river-themed, family yoga class. Shifts available: 8:30am to 10:30am for September 20.

Quayside Tour – Assist participants during a Quayside walking tour down the New West boardwalk. Shifts available: 10:15am to 11:45am for September 20.

Horticulture Walk – Assist participants during a plant walk down the New West boardwalk. Shifts available: 11:45am to 1:15pm for September 20.

Smartphone Photography – Assist participants during a smartphone photography workshop on the New West boardwalk. Shifts available: 1:45pm to 4:15pm for September 20.

Set-up – volunteers are needed to chalk off exhibitor booths, set up tents, tables, and chairs. <u>Shifts available:</u> 8:30am to 9:45am for September 27.

Fire Lane Parking Control – volunteers are needed to assist with traffic control and exhibitor drop-off. <u>Shifts available:</u> 8:30am to 9:45am for September 27.

Arts New West Workshop – volunteers are needed to assist Arts New West during an art workshop. Shifts available: 9:30am to 12:15pm and 12:45pm to 3:15pm for both September 27 and 28.

Salmon Ladder Activity – volunteers are needed to introduce guests to various kinds of fish passage infrastructure and how the design of fishways must be adapted to fish behaviour!
