The Fraser River Discovery Centre (FRDC) is seeking volunteers 15 years and older to assist during the Tourism Challenge. The Tourism Challenge is an annual event that encourages tourism industry professionals to explore the various attractions around them.

Volunteering at the FRDC is educational, rewarding, and fun! You'll engage with learners of all ages and help inspire stewards of the river.

Responsibilities:

- Provide FRDC challenge details to Tourism Challenge participants.
- Check IDs against Tourism Challenge passports.
- Check answers to challenge questions.
- Stamp Tourism Challenge passports.
- Answer general questions about the Fraser River Discovery Centre.

Time Commitment:

- Volunteers must commit to at least one 3.5-hour shift either in the morning or afternoon, Wednesday through Sunday, from April 18 to May 31.

General Volunteer Requirements:

- Must be 15 years of age or older.
- A desire to work and interact with children and families.
- Enjoy public speaking.
- Interest in science communication and/or local history.

General Volunteer Benefits:

- Opportunity to engage with learners of all ages and learn about the Fraser River.
- Free admission to the FRDC over the course of your placement.
- Gain work experience to add to your resume!
- After completing a **minimum of 15 volunteer hours**, you become eligible for a Tourism Challenge passport.
- Access to other tourist attractions.
- After successfully completing your volunteer service, you can request a Letter of Reference and Proof of Completion Letter which states the total hours volunteered.
